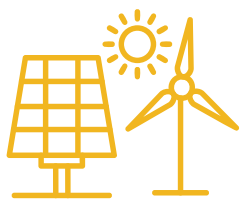

Four 100% electric buses and electric infrastructure



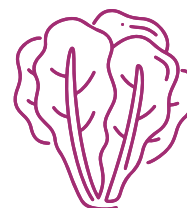
17 projects funded by Campus Sustainability Innovation Fund
