The HBS SSA Program, now in its 20th year, is the school's peer-to-peer education program that promotes sustainable living and working on campus.

Ten SSAs (one per RC section) are hired each year to connect with their classmates on sustainability through the lenses of climate, health, and wellness for all. SSAs engage their peers in campaigns that span waste diversion, transportation, food selection, and more.

SSAs suggest and pursue sustainability infrastructure and policy improvements for HBS. SSAs will also serve as advisers to the HBS Business & Environment Initiative (BEI), participating at BEI/SSA meetings twice a year.

Commitment through May 2027. Applications received by September 3rd given priority.

Must be an HBS RC student. International students are welcome to apply. Note that Fulbright scholars are unfortunately unable to be hired.

- 15) As part of your role as an SSA, you will act as a partner and provide feedback to the Business & Environment Initiative (BEI) on matters of curriculum, co-curricular activities, faculty interactions, School support systems for careers and other activities, and community. What is your vision of different ways the School should be supporting students around the topic of sustainability, and what topics do you care most about?
- 16) SSAs meet as a team and with the Sustainability team in Operations every other week at a mutually-agreed-upon time. As an SSA, you must attend these bi-weekly meetings. What particular commitments, if any, beyond academics may impact your availability for these meetings and other core SSA Program activities?
